Congratulations to all anglers who have qualified to fish in the ABN High School State Championship on June 7th & 8th on Lake Eufaula. Please refer to the State Championship Qualification document for anglers who officially qualified. Daily launch and weigh in will be from Lake Point State Park.

Official practice will be Saturday June 3rd – Thursday June 6th, 2019 ***During official practice, ALL tournament rules must be obeyed.*** This includes:

- No soliciting or receiving any information about Lake Eufaula from anyone not registered for this tournament.
- Wearing of life vest (PFD) **at ALL times** when gasoline engine is on. PFD must be zipped or snapped with kill switch hooked up and working.

Online Entry for this event is the same and you can find it on our website albassnation.org/HighSchool
All entries must be registered online by **May 31st**. (***Late fee for entries received between June 1st-June 2nd at Noon, entries received after that will not compete in State Championship.***)

Tournament Headquarters will be at the Lake Point State Park Lodge, Mandatory briefing at 5:30P.M. at Lake Point Resort Meeting Room, 104 Lake Point Drive Eufaula.

Only Top 3, 6-Man Teams from each of the Tide Regional qualifiers and the top 3, 6-Man Teams from the Tiger Regional qualifiers will be allowed to fish in the 6-Man team competition at State.

Please reference the attached TIDE-6-Man Team State Qualification Document for clarification which teams will compete in the 6-Man team competition.

If any of the original team members cannot make it, you will be allowed 2 substitutions per 6-Angler Team. You must have at least 4 to fish in the team format. All substitutions must have qualified for State Championship also. The qualified 6-Man Teams mentioned above (along with the Tiger Division qualified 6-Man Teams) will compete for **School/Team of the Year** honors in the **2-Day Competition**. We will recognize the Top 3 Schools after Day 2 and the 1st place will be awarded School/Team of the Year! Good luck to all of you and be safe on the water.
